Admission, registration and grants

Admission requirements

To apply for postgraduate studies, applicants must hold an official Spanish university degree, or any other degree awarded by an Institution of Higher Education within the European Higher Education Area (EHEA), with a level of academic training, within the specific country, equivalent to official Spanish University Qualifications.

Students with official university degrees from countries outside the EHEA must submit a document from their university of origin assuring that the studies completed qualify for postgraduate education. Access via this channel shall not imply, in any case, the homologation of the degree, nor its recognition for any purpose other than that of taking postgraduate studies.

Before pre-registering, applicants must ensure they meet all entry requirements for the program as well as possessing the necessary documentation.

Students should consult the UIMP's web page for the procedure and the pre-registration period established for each program.

Admission of candidates is decided by the Academic Commission of each study program.

General admission criteria

- Degree in the study area of your choice
- Average grade in academic transcripts
- Having participated in other training programs
- Proven mobility during degree studies
- Professional experience in subjects related to the study program

Minimum number of enrollments and requirements

The number of students enrolled on each postgraduate course cannot be less than ten (10). Postgraduate courses in which there are fewer than 10 enrollments will be cancelled.

The UIMP has established a set of requirements for all postgraduate studies with a limit to the number of times a student can sit an exam and to the time in which the studies should be completed.
